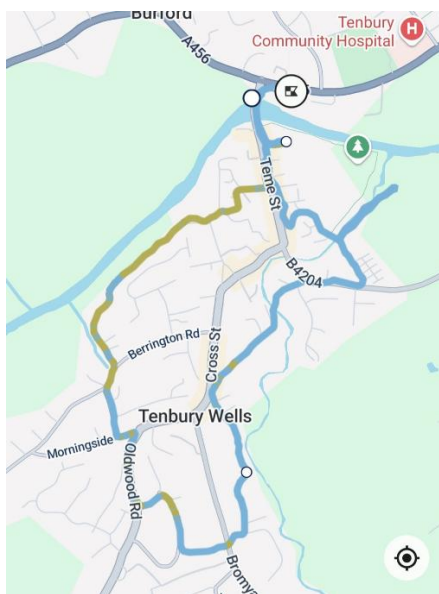
PCSO Durrant – Tenbury Family Fun Day
